The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Thursday, November 12, 2009 in the City Hall meeting room, 411 Main Street at 6:00 p.m. Councilmen present were Jared Eggleston, Ryan Young, Ron Samsel and Jim Stonequist. Councilman David Rogers was absent. Department heads present were City Superintendent Chris Cross.

The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

Mayor Lytle called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Councilman Ryan Young moved to approve the consent agenda with the following amendment: Insert name of Councilman (Jared Eggleston) making the motion on Page One, Para. 10. Councilman Ron Samsel seconded. Motion passed 4 to 0.

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments that had not been previously placed on the agenda.

There were no public comments.

Council discussed a proposed burn permit ordinance that had been compiled from several other city ordinances.

Consensus was to not do a burn permit ordinance at this time. Currently citizens are allowed to burn in approved containers and the City is providing a place for leaves to be dumped.

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to not pass a burn permit ordinance at this time. Councilman Jim Stonequist seconded. Motion passed 4 to 0.

City Superintendent Chris Cross gave a public works department activity report. The new section of waterline on Elm Street has been tested and approved; the department will start moving residential connections to the new line very soon.

Jeanine Berrier informed Council that the Planning Commission has scheduled a public hearing next Wednesday to discuss three zoning regulation text amendments.

Councilman Jim Stonequist moved to adjourn. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 4 to 0.

The meeting adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
