The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, February 10, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. in the City Hall meeting room at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Ryan Young, Jared Eggleston, Ron Samsel and Jim Stonequist. Councilman David Rogers was absent. Department heads present were Chief of Police Steve Gillespie and Fire Department member Rick Souders was present in place of absent Fire Chief Robert Thomas. City Attorney Patrick Reavey entered later in the meeting.

The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

Mayor Lytle called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Councilman Jim Stonequist moved to approve the consent agenda as submitted. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments that had not been previously placed on the agenda.

There were no public comments.

Franklin County Commissioner Don Stottlemire gave a brief update on County activities.

Commissioner Stottlemire provided the City with a copy of the County's 2009 ambulance report.

The report indicates that the Wellsville ambulance site location has cut down response times in this section of the county and has been considered a good investment for the County.

Mayor Lytle initiated discussion about a property on K33 that had done some excavating in the past.

Council consensus was to have staff check into code compliances for the activities that are occurring on the property.

Chief of Police Steve Gillespie gave a police department activity report.

Rick Souders informed the Council that one of the bay heaters needs to be replaced. The department had received a bid of \$1600.00 installed (this unit fits the current piping).

A & A Service Company submitted a bid of \$1200.00 for the radiant heater and an additional bid of \$400 for fresh air return. Fruends submitted a bid of \$1600.00 for the radiant heat.

The fire department submitted a request for a cell phone adapter. The cost of the adapter is \$350.00.

Council asked Mr. Souders to get more information on the heater for the department.

Councilman Ryan Young moved to purchase a \$350.00 cell phone adapter for the fire department. Councilman Jim Stonequist seconded. Motion passed 4 to 0.

**Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to adjourn. Councilman Ron Samsel seconded.
Motion passed 4 to 0.**

The meeting adjourned 6:30 p.m.
