The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, July 27, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. in the City Hall meeting room, 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Ryan Young, Jared Eggleston, Mike McAfee, David Rogers and Cory Cunningham. Department heads present were City Supt. Christopher Cross, Fire Chief Robert Thomas and Chief of Police Steve Gillespie.

Mayor Lytle called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

Councilman Mike McAfee moved to approve the consent agenda as submitted. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 5-0

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments that had not been previously placed on the agenda.

There were no public comments.

Franklin County Commissioner Don Stottlemire was present and gave Council an update on current county activities.

Commissioner Stottlemire stated he is the Chairman of adopt a bike program and they are accepting all new and used bikes at the recycling center in Ottawa along with any donations for Reading Ks. tornado victims.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to approve the publishing of the 2012 budget summary. Councilman Mike McAfee seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to adopt ordinance 832 motorized wheeled devices. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 5-0

Councilman Ryan Young moved to approved ordinance 833. Dave Rogers seconded. Motion passed 4-1. Councilman Eggleston voted no.

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to appoint Sandra Hausler to the Library board. Mike McAfee seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to approve the closing of Main street between 5th and 6th streets for the annual Hallowesta on October 29th from 4:30 to 5:45. Councilman Mike McAfee seconded. Motion passed 5-0

City Supt. Cross gave a public works activity report.

Supt. Cross informed Council that the sewer rehabilitation project is going as expected.

Supt. Cross stated that the pool addition is moving along slowly, with some repairs needed.

Supt. Cross spoke regarding the sidewalks. He is suggesting taking from Maple to first then west to Locust which will be new sidewalks. Supt. Cross stated they would have curb there to protect the sidewalk. It was the consensus of the council to have Supt. Cross look into placing new sidewalks in that area.

Chief Gillespie gave the Police Department activity report.

Fire Chief Robert Thomas gave the Fire Department activity report. Chief Thomas stated they are looking at replacing their structure gloves. There will be a boot block in Ottawa on the 3rd of Sept. Chief Thomas wants to take a Fire Truck to Ottawa at 23rd St.

Chief Thomas stated that the Fire Marshalls office contacted him and wants him to start inspecting the Daycares in the City and they would need to be registered with the City and we would have their contact information. It was council's consensus for Chief Thomas to check with the Fire Marshalls office and see if he would be an agent for them.

Chief Thomas requested the purchase of new pagers at \$200 each. Council approved the purchase.

Council discussed taking the Fire Truck to Ottawa for the boot block, it was the consensus of the Council to have a back up plan in case there is a Fire call to be discussed at a later date. The City Clerk will check with the insurance company to see if we are covered while in Ottawa.

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to adjourn. Councilman Mike McAfee seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

The meeting adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
