The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, February 14th 2018 at 6:10 p.m. in the Wellsville City Council meeting room, located at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Chuck Rutledge, Cory Cunningham and Kiel Lasswell. Department heads present were City Superintendent Christopher Cross and Building Inspector Jerry Mallory. Officer Rachele Foltz filled in for Chief Blair.

Councilman Tony Stanton and David Rogers were absent.

The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge moved to approve the consent agenda. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments. There were no comments.

Councilman David Rogers entered the meeting at 6:12 p.m.

The pool manager position was discussed for the 2018 pool season. Mary Ann Chambers has applied again.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge moved to approve Mary Ann Chambers as pool manager. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

The City staff will be calling around to other towns for cost of pool rates.

Nicole Vlcek has resigned the planning commission as of February 21st, she has moved out of the city limits.

Councilman David Rogers moved to accept Nicole Vlceks resignation. Councilman Kiel Lasswell seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Planning Commission Chairman Jeanine Berrier asked council if the planning commission could move their meetings from 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

City Superintendent Christopher Cross gave the Public Works activity report. Chris stated that the pool project is moving along quite nicely. Chris also stated that the main pool pump failed last year and when they tore into the pump it is not repairable. A new pool 3 phase commercial pump from Hayward would run \$2400.00.

Councilman Cory Cunningham moved to approve the purchase of the Hayward phase 3 pump for the pool in the amount of \$2400.00. Councilman Kiel Lasswell seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Officer Rachele Foltz gave the Police Department activity report.

Building Inspector Jerry Mallory gave the Planning Department report.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge motioned that the City Council recess into executive session at 6:30 p.m. to discuss performance of non-elected personnel pursuant to K.S.A. 75-4319(b)(1). The open meeting will resume in the City Council chambers at 6:45 p.m. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed

Councilman Chuck moved to come out of executive session. Councilman Cory seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

No motions were made and only the above mentioned item was discussed.

Councilman Kiel Lasswell moved to adjourn. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 4-0.
