Regular Council Meeting
6:00 p.m.

The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, January 12, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. in the City Hall meeting room, 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Ryan Young, Jared Eggleston, Ron Samsel and Jim Stonequist. Councilman Dave Rogers was absent. Department heads present were Fire Chief Robert Thomas and City Supt. Chris Cross.

The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

Mayor Lytle called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Councilman Ron Samsel moved to approve the consent agenda as submitted. Councilman Ryan Young seconded. Motion passed. 4 to 0.

Mayor Lyle opened the meeting up for comments that had not been previously placed on the agenda.

New Wellsville Days committee member Kevin Jones was present to give Council a brief update on the current stage of planning for the 2011 event. The date of September 23rd through the 25th has been selected for 2011. A theme is yet to be decided on.

Franklin Co Commissioner Don Stottlemire was present and informed Council of current County activities. Recap: Commissioner Ed Taylor will be the 2011 Chairman. Commissioner Don Stottlemire will be Vice Chairman. County has received a grant for a portable communication tower. Commissioners will have a meeting next week to make a decision on the final design plans for the new juvenile facility.

The EMT reimbursement agreement was resubmitted. Council had asked that the word "employment" be stricken from the document and the word "volunteer" be used in place of it. The City Attorney edited the document and resubmitted.

Councilman Ryan Young moved to adopt the submitted EMT reimbursement agreement. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 4 to 0.

Fire Chief Robert Thomas gave a brief fire department activity report.

City Superintendent Christopher Cross gave a public works activity report. The department is currently tied up with snow removal due to the snow storm we received on Monday.

Councilman Jim Stonequist moved to approve a \$.50 per hour raise for public works employee Levi Harn retro to the beginning of 2011. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 4 to 0.

City Clerk Donna Layton read aloud a police department activity report.

Council asked Supt. Cross to look into where the Engineers are on the bid documents for the city's current sewer project.

Councilman Jim Stonequist moved to adjourn. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 3 to 1. Councilman Samsel voted no.

The meeting adjourned at 6:35 p.m.
