The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, October 25th 2017 at 6:00 p.m. in the Wellsville City Council meeting room, located at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Chuck Rutledge, David Rogers, Tony Stanton and Kiel Lasswell. Department heads present were Police Chief John Blair, City Superintendent Christopher Cross and Building Inspector Jerry Mallory.

Councilman Cory Cunningham was absent.

The Pledge of allegiance and invocation was given.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to approve the consent agenda. Councilman Tony Stanton seconded. Motion passed 4-0

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments. There were no public comments.

County Commissioner Randy Renoud gave the County Activity report. The visitors and information center are looking for new board members. Some repairs will be needed at the visitor's center. Some repairs to the Courthouse were also discussed along with some of the trees on the courthouse lawn.

Cassie Myers with the Willow Domestic Violence Center spoke to Council and stated that they service all of Franklin County and will come pick up survivors if necessary. They also have a youth violence program that they go into the Schools to discuss. Cassie stated they have been serving Franklin County for over 20 years.

The City Code Proposal and placing the code online along with a yearly maintenance was discussed. The base cost is \$1250.00 for codification services with an annual fee of \$950.00

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to approve the code proposal and the maintenance fee. Councilman Chuck Rutledge seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

City Superintendent Christopher Cross gave the Public Works activity report. He stated the street sweeping will start next week. The pool coating was discussed and the cost. The new coating warranty is for one year. The baby pool and the slide pool are getting rough; the coating looks good but may need painted next year. The Continental Pool Company is the only one we have a bid from at this point. Supt. Cross is waiting on some of the other companies to send their bids.

The Mayor talked about striping 1st street. City Superintendent Cross stated by law we do not have to have it striped, but the Mayor would like to have pricing if possible.

Chief John Blair gave the Police Department activity report. Chief Blair has been to several meetings regarding the radios. A service bulletin came out on the SUVs regarding fumes. They have to take all 3 of the SUVs in and do a maintenance check.

Building Inspector Jerry Mallory gave an update on the property at 918 Main. The property has been sold and will be torn down.

There is a new business in town called Main Street Surplus.

Bill Thompson with Select Steel will be meeting with the Mayor and Jerry next week to discuss plans of moving the business to Wellsville.

Jerry also stated that a new Casey's will be coming to town. They plan to purchase the old Wellsville Market and build a brand new building.

Councilman Kiel Lasswell made a motion that the City Council recess into executive session at 6:23 p.m. to discuss performance of non-elected personnel pursuant to K.S.A. 75-4319(b)(1). The open meeting will resume in the City Council chambers at 6:28 p.m. Councilman Tony Stanton seconded. Motion passed 4-3-0.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge move to came out of executive session. Councilman Tony Stanton seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Council came out of executive session at 6:28 p.m. no motions were made and only the above mentioned item was discussed.

Councilman Kiel Lasswell moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Dave Rogers seconded. Motion passed 4-0
