Councilman Dave Rogers moved to approve the consent agenda. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 3-0

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to approve the purchase of the hot water heater for \$400.00 from Heritage tractor. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Chief Blair gave the Police Department activity report. Chief Blair stated that Wellsville Days went very well and there were no complaints.

Building Inspector Wes Brown discussed possibly using the Police Departments car 005 as a planning commission car. Consensus was to table this until the next meeting and for Wes to come up with some figures to support using the Impala.

Councilman Jared Eggleston requested to go into executive session for 10 minutes to discuss personnel and land acquisition. Councilman Dave Rogers seconded.
