The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, November 30th 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the Wellsville City Hall meeting room, located at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Jared Eggleston, Dave Rogers and Cory Cunningham. Department heads present were City Superintendent Christopher Cross and Police Officer Danny Hackler for Chief Blair.

Councilmen absent were Chuck Rutledge and Ryan Eiche.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to approve the consent agenda. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments there were not public comments.

County Commissioner Randall Renoud gave the county activity report.

Jared Eggleston gave a board report for the Fire Department. He stated that they are purchasing a new fire truck from Olathe, it is a 2000 4-wheel drive pickup. They paid \$5500.00. December 1st they will have a new pumper that they will purchase from Olathe as well.

The Main Street Sewer issue was discussed at 102 Maple. The Multi level home routinely experiences sewer backups into its lowest level during times of heavy rainfall. After Several unsuccessful attempts to resolve the issue themselves, the homeowner has reached out to the City for help with a solution. There were several options including a backflow valve which would retail for \$40-\$140.

Consensus was for Superintendent Cross to talk to the homeowners about the backflow valve and see if they would be in favor of that idea and also sharing the cost then we would revisit the subject bring on December 14th.

The memo regarding Christmas bonuses were discussed. The bonuses would equate to \$750.00 for full time and \$375.00 for part time.

Cory Cunningham moved to approve the bonuses at \$750.00 for full time and \$375.00 for part time. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

City Superintendent Christopher Cross gave the public works activity report. Supt. Cross stated that the concrete seams in the 1st and Ash Intersection need to be addressed and the cost is approximately \$5000.00.

Officer Danny Hackler gave the police department activity report.

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Dave Rogers seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Meeting adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
