The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, December 14, 2011 at 6:00 in the City Hall meeting room, 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Ryan Young, Jared Eggleston, Mike McAfee, Cory Cunningham and David Rogers. Department heads present were Chief of Police Steve Gillespie, City Supt. Christopher Cross and Fire Chief Robert Thomas and City Prosecutor Patrick Reavey.

The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

Mayor Lytle called the meeting to order at 6:00

Councilman Ryan Young moved to approve the consent agenda as submitted.. Councilman Mike McAfee seconded. Motion passed 5-0

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments that had not been previously placed on the agenda.

There were no additional public comments.

Franklin Co Commissioner Don Stottlemire gave a county activity report. County items mentioned were medical calls and a grant purchasing gurneys.

Hurricane Sherry's owner Sherry Watts requested to extend New Year's Eve business hours from midnight to two a.m .

Councilman Mike McAfee moved to extend business hours from midnight to two am on New Years day. Councilman Dave Rogers seconded. Motion passed 5-0

Ty and Amy Stevenson requested to waive their building permit fee-new home construction due to fire.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to forgive the building permit fees at 242 Prairie Lane. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 5-0

Vernon Fraley-request to allow open agricultural burning at 210 E. 10<sup>th</sup>. Council discussed possible burn permits on Saturday's only. It was requested by council for Wes Brown to check with Gardner and Baldwin to get the language of how their ordinance is written.

**Councilman Mike McAfee moved to table this discussion until the next meeting. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 5-0**

**Councilman Mike McAfee moved to approve a Christmas bonus of \$750.00 for full time employees and \$375.00 for part time employees. Councilman Dave Rogers seconded. Motion passed 5-0.**

**City Supt. Chris Cross gave a public works activity report.**

**Police Chief Steve Gillespie gave a police department activity report. Also discussed were the NIMS training and how to take the classes. Chief Gillespie also said he is working with County Commissioner Stottlemire on delivering 15 bicycles to needy children in Wellsville.**

**Fire Chief Robert Thomas gave a fire department activity report.**

**Councilman Ryan Young requested the Public Safety committee have a meeting regarding emergency management.**

**Building Inspector Wes Brown stated he will have some plans drawn up for ideas for the Police Department remodel at the December 21<sup>st</sup> Christmas luncheon from 12-2**

**Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to adjourn. Councilman Mike McAfee seconded. Motion passed 5-0.**
