The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Tuesday, March 11, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. in the Wellsville City Hall meeting room, located at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Jared Eggleston, Mike McAfee, Cory Cunningham, Dave Edwards and Travis Jones. Department heads present were City Superintendent Christopher Cross, Building Inspector Wes Brown and Police Chief John Blair.

The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

Mayor Lytle called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Councilman Mike McAfee moved to approve the consent agenda. Councilman Dave Edwards seconded. Motion passed 5-0

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments that had not been previously placed on the agenda.

There were no comments.

Commissioner Don Stottlemire gave the County activity report. A letter will be arriving discussing the spring cleanup dates which are May 1-3rd for Wellsville. They will be taking roll offs till May 5th & 6th.

Chief Blair spoke regarding the replacement proposal for the police vehicle. The low bid was from Shawnee Mission Ford.

Councilman Travis Jones moved to buy 2 new SUV vehicles from Shawnee Mission Ford, black in color thru the 3 year lease program at a cost of \$9065.92 per car per year. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 4-0. Councilman Mike McAfee voted no.

Consensus of the council was to have the black chiefs car and car 91 inspected to see which car is in better shape.

Councilman Dave Edwards moved to accept the Insurance payment of \$6522.25 from the insurance company to total the car. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

The pool was discussed with Thatcher Decker being the manager again. The consensus of the council was to put it out for bid.

City Clerk Donna Layton spoke about the utility clerk's position, and that the office would like to move Erin Eggleston into that position. It was stated that they would like to ask City Attorney Reavey if there is any problems with promoting from within.

Councilman Cory Cunningham moved to approve the hiring of Erin Eggleston at a salary of 12.50 contingents upon City Attorney Reavey stating there would be no legal ramifications. Councilman Mike McAfee seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Councilman Travis Jones moved to approve keeping Ottawa Sanitation as our trash service provider. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Councilman Travis Jones moved to approve replacing the awnings at City Hall at a cost of \$968.97 with Full Bright Sign. Councilman Dave Edwards seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

City Superintendent Chris Cross gave the public works activity report.

Interim Chief Blair gave the police department activity report. Chief Blair spoke about the furnace that needs to be replaced because it cannot be repaired.

Councilman Travis Jones moved to take the A&H bid for the furnace at \$1700.00. Councilman Dave Edwards seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Building Inspector Wes Brown spoke regarding Resolution 001-212-2014 which involves citations per violation with not less than \$50.00 not more than \$100.00.

The consensus of the council is to cite the owner \$100.00 every other week. We will revisit the topic if they have not been remedied.

Councilman Dave Edwards moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Mike McAfee seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Meeting adjourned at 7:14.
