The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, April 13th, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the Wellsville City Hall meeting room, located at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Chuck Rutledge, Jared Eggleston, Dave Rogers. Department heads present were City Superintendent Christopher Cross, Police Chief John Blair, Building Inspector Wes Brown and City Engineer Mike Brungardt.

Councilman Cory Cunningham and Ryan Eiche were absent.

The pledge of allegiance and Invocation were given.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to approve the consent agenda.
Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments. There were no public comments.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to approve Resolution 01-0413-16 Establishing fees and rates for permits, licenses and services. Councilman Chuck Rutledge seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Mike Brungardt spoke about the contract agreement with BNSF and that there are fees attached. A check for \$4,046.00 which covers the contract fee will have to be paid. In lieu of providing a separate policy for Railroad Protective Liability Insurance the City can purchase Insurance from BNSF in the amount of \$ 1,150.00.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge moved to approve the \$ 4,046.00 and the \$1,150.00 to be paid to BNSF out of the Capital Improvement fund. Councilman Chuck Rutledge seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

County Commissioner Randy Renoud came into the meeting late and gave the County activity report.

The special use permit for Chili Jacks for alumni night was discussed.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to approve the special events permit on May 14th for the alumni banquet. Councilman Chuck Rutledge seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

A study session was discussed for building and codes. The date of Monday, May 2nd at 6:00 p.m. was decided upon, the meeting will be held in the City Hall meeting room.

Mayor Lytle discussed the K-33 corridor visioning project meeting that will be held on Monday, April 25, 2016 at the Wellsville Library at 5:30 to 7:30 p.m.

City Superintendent Christopher Cross gave the Public Works activity report. Supt. Cross spoke about the topic of an additional handicap spot. Mr. Cross gave drawings to the council with 2 options. The consensus of the council was to paint a handicap spot and see if that would work before spending any additional money.

Police Chief John Blair gave the Police Department activity report. A stop sign was requested at the Library corner east and west. The Chief suggested making that area a 20 mile an hour zone instead of 25. The consensus was for the Police Department to monitor that area closely and report back to the council.

Building Inspector Wes Brown did not have anything for the council.

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Dave Rogers seconded. Motion passed 3-0.
