The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, May 14, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. in the Wellsville City hall meeting room, located at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Dave Edwards, Cory Cunningham, Jared Eggleston, Mike McAfee and Dave Rogers.

The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

Mayor Lytle called the meeting at order at 6:00 p.m.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to approve the consent agenda. Councilman Mike McAfee seconded.

Motion passed 5-0

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting for public comments. There were no public comments.

Commissioner Don Stottlemire gave the County activity report. Mr. Stottlemire gave the ambulance report and also the clean-up totals by rural town.

Councilman Mike McAfee requested the council to look at the current curfew ordinance. There was discussion on the current ordinance and the time limits that are in place.

Councilman Mike McAfee made a motion to amend Ordinance 833- 16 and over to a 2:00 a.m. curfew. Councilman Dave Edwards seconded.

Councilman Dave Edwards and Mike McAfee voted yea. Councilman Dave Rogers, Councilman Cory Cunningham and Councilman Jared Eggleston voted no.

Motion failed 3-2

Councilman Mike McAfee moved to table the Pit Bull ordinance until the next meeting. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Councilman Mike McAfee moved to approve the special permit for May 17th for a beer garden for Chili-Jacks from noon-midnight. Councilman Dave Edwards seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

The water irrigation was discussed along with the cost. The city has a request from a citizen for a meter to be set to an adjoining lot to irrigate.

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to proceed to establish an ordinance on irrigation pricing. No deposit on any additional meter. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

City Superintendent Christopher Cross gave the public works activity report. Project updates, Mike Brungardt and Chris had a meeting with The City of Baldwin on the water side. Chris spoke about the electronic meter reading system and he sent out a universal proposal to all companies.

Superintendent Cross talked about the De Soto's City Council's desire to terminate the interlocal agreement that formed the Sunflower Public Water Utility.

Councilman Dave Edwards moved to terminate the agreement with Desoto. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Superintendent Cross spoke about Mike Brungardts response to the CMM and the SRF funding. He also talked about issues regarding the interior of the pool. Supt. Cross also spoke about the street projects and a 7th street overlay. Supt. Cross stated that Killough Const. could give us an estimate. Supt. Cross will look into a possible core sample, if needed.

Police Chief John Blair gave a police department activity report. Chief Blair is interviewing possible candidates for Police Officer. Chief Blair spoke about the need to replace an in car camera the cost is anywhere from \$4000.00- \$4300.00. Councilman Dave Rogers requested concrete figures. Chief Blair stated he is having a meeting next week with the representative.

Building Inspector Wes Brown gave a codes report and tall weed and grass violations.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Mike McAfee seconded. Motion passed 5-0
