The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, June 11, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. in the Wellsville City Hall meeting room, located at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Jared Eggleston, Dave Rogers, Mike McAfee, Dave Edwards and Cory Cunningham.

The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

Mayor Lytle called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m

Councilman Cory Cunningham moved to approve the consent agenda. Councilman Dave Edwards seconded. Motion passed 5-0

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting for public comments. There were no public comments.

Commissioner Don Stottlemire gave the County activity report. Mr. Stottlemire stated Lisa Johnson stepped down as the County Administrator. Mr. Stottlemire said they have already spoken to a possible candidate to replace her.

Pat Stonequist stated she had trouble with the cemetery this year concerning things that were taken that should not have been. Pat also complained about the crosswalks from 4<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> streets. Mrs. Stonequist stated that the crosswalks were not marked.

Rick Ensz gave the council a cost analysis on the refunding on the waste water system.

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to table the refunding per City Attorney Reavey's approval. Councilman Mike McAfee seconded. Motion passed.

The AMR Meter presentation slide show was presented by HD Supply, along with some material for Council's review.

Mike Brungardt spoke about the text amendment for accessory structures and uses and also about shipping containers within the City.

Councilman Mike McAfee moved to approve ordinance 859 on shipping containers. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 6-0

Councilman Mike McAfee moved to approve ordinance 860 with the change of the wording in Section 1 to read Allowed instead of Permitted. Councilman Dave Edwards seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

City Superintendent Chris Cross gave the public works activity report. Chris talked to the council about Street work and gave them some figures from Killough Const.

City Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to approve Killough Const. to do the 7<sup>th</sup> street overlay project not to exceed \$100,000.00. Councilman Mike McAfee seconded.

Motion passed 5-0.

Police Chief John Blair gave the Police Department activity report.

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to go into executive session to discuss personnel not to exceed 15 minutes. City Prosecutor Patrick Reavey and City Clerk Tammy Jones were asked to stay. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Council went into executive session at 8:35.

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to come out of executive session at 8:50. Councilman Dave Edwards seconded. No motions were made and only the above item was mentioned.

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to go back into executive session for 10 minutes. Councilman Dave Rogers seconded. Council went back into executive session at 8:50.

Councilman Mike McAfee moved to come out of executive session. Councilman Dave Rogers seconded. Council came out of executive session at 9:01. Not motions were made and only the above item was mentioned and no motions were made.

Councilman Dave Rogers move to approve the base salary of Officer Ward and Officer Early to \$36,000.00. Base salary is \$32,500.00 with a raise given after completion of one years' service. Councilman Dave Edwards seconded. Motion passed 4-0. Councilman Mike McAfee voted no.

Councilman Cory Cunningham moved to adjourn. Councilman Dave Edwards seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Council adjourned at 9:15.
