The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, June 14<sup>th</sup> 2017 at 6:00 p.m. in the Wellsville City Council meeting room, located at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Dave Rogers, Kiel Lasswell, Tony Stanton, Chuck Rutledge and Cory Cunningham. Department heads present was Police Chief John Blair.

Mayor Lytle called the meeting to order.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge moved to approve the consent agenda. Councilman Kiel Lasswell seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments. There were no public comments.

Gregg Neis discussed the budget. The budget meeting will be held on June 26<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m. at the City Hall meeting room.

Chief Blair gave the police department activity report. Chief Blair gave the council information on the radios and Firearms Instructor School. The cost of the radios would approximately be \$37,000.00 with payments over 12 years. Council discussed paying the \$28,000.00 that we have saved and make a payment a year over 3 years. Chief Blair requested to send Officer Coughlin to the Firearms Instructor School.

Councilman Cory Cunningham requested a 5 minute executive session to discuss personnel. Councilman Kiel Lasswell seconded. Motion passed 5-0. Council went into executive session at 6:24 p.m. Chief Blair was asked to stay.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to come out of executive session. Councilman Chuck Rutledge seconded. Motion passed 5-0. Council came out of executive session at 6:33 p.m. no motions were made and only the above mentioned item was discussed.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to send officer Coughlin to firearms school the cost would be \$450.00. Councilman Chuck Rutledge seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Chief Blair stated the Police department will need a new water heater the cost is under \$200.00.

Councilman Cory Cunningham moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Kiel Lasswell seconded. Motion passed 5-0.
