A special meeting/budget workshop was held on Tuesday, July 19, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. at The Wellsville City Hall meeting room, 411 Main Street. City Auditor Greg Neis gave a budget presentation to the council with a 3. % increase. A mil brings in \$11,516.00. Sales tax revenues are down so far this year. The desired Mil rate for 2017 mil levy would be 50.599 which is 3.4 mils.

Becky Dodd with the Library board was present to talk about her budget request for 2017. Becky said she is currently working on grant money. The total requested from the City of Wellsville is \$86,777.00 with benefits.

Supt. Cross discussed eliminating a part time position for a lower paid full time position.

Prairie Paws requested \$1030.00. \$ 1000.00 was budgeted in 2016.
