The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, August 10<sup>th</sup> 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the Wellsville City Hall meeting room, located at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Jared Eggleston, Ryan Eiche, Dave Rogers and Cory Cunningham. Department heads present were city Superintendent Christopher Cross, Police Chief John Blair and Building inspector Wes Brown.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge was absent.

The pledge of allegiance and Invocation were given

The Mayor called the 2017 budget-meeting to order.

The Mayor opened the hearing up for public comments. There were no public comments.

The Mayor closed the budget hearing to the public.

End of public hearing.

The Mayor called the regular meeting to order.

Councilman Cory Cunningham moved to approve the consent agenda. Councilman Ryan Eiche seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

The Mayor opened the meeting up for public comments. There were no comments.

County Commissioner Randall Renoud gave the County activity report. Commissioner Renoud gave the council a 2017 budget overview to council.

The council discussed Resolution 01-0810-2016 expressing the property taxation policy of the Wellsville governing body with respect to financing the annual budget for 2017. Councilman Dave Rogers moved to approve the resolution. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 4-0

The 2017 budget was presented to the council. Councilman Dave Rogers moved to approve the 2017 budget as presented. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Clayton Neel with the Wellsville Car Show discussed the upcoming show and the events involved. He stated the car show will be Friday, August 26<sup>th</sup> at 4 p.m. on the bricks.

Clint Robertson spoke to the council about blocking the street on Meadowbrook Lane or part of the street from Elm to mid street on Saturday, Sept. 17<sup>th</sup> for a party. He stated it will be in the afternoon into the evening hours.

The council discussed having the approval of the whole block. Council suggested getting the whole blocks approval and to come back on August 31<sup>st</sup>.

City Superintendent Christopher Cross gave the Public Works activity report. He gave the council copies of the storage tank inspections. The Mayor asked about excess chips on the streets. Chris said he could get a price from an outside contractor.

Chief John Blair gave the Police Department activity report. Chief stated that he had an officer at DARE Camp. Active Shooter training will be coming up on August 16<sup>th</sup> at the School.

Building Inspector Wes Brown talked about an upcoming conference for KACE and the costs involved, he wanted to share those with the council.

Wes also spoke about the landlord program; he has 2 landlords who have agreed to participate. He requested 2 councilmen to participate and he thought they may have a few night meetings.

Wes spoke about the economic development meeting held on Monday with James Oltman. Topic discussions were possible policies, incentives, commercial development and where growth would be expected.

Councilman Dave Rogers requested a 15 minute executive session for land acquisition. Councilman Cory seconded. Motion passed 4-0. Council went into executive session at 6:38 p.m.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to come out of executive session. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 4-0. Council came out of executive session at 6:53 p.m. only the above mentioned item was discussed and no motions were made.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 4-0.
