The regular meeting of the City of Wellsville was held on August 31st, 2011 at the City Hall meeting room. Councilmen present were Dave Rogers, Jared Eggleston, Mike McAfee and Ryan Young. Cory Cunningham was absent. Department heads present were Chief Gillespie, City Supt. Chris Cross, Fire Chief Robert Thomas and Building Inspector Wes Brown.

The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

Councilman Ryan Young moved to approve the consent agenda. Councilman Mike McAfee seconded. Motion passed 4-0

Mayor Lytle opened the public hearing up for public comments.

Kevin Jones with the Wellsville Days Committee discussed what they would need from the City for Wellsville Days. He provided a list for each council member.

Commissioner Don Stottlemire provided Council with information on County activities.

Mike Chilton from Chili Jacks spoke regarding putting a beer garden in front of his business for Wellsville Days. He explained that his insurance will cover all liability of this event. Councilman Dave Rogers moved to table the motion. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 4-0 to table Mr. Chilton's request until the next council meeting on Sept. 14, 2011.

City Engineer Mike Brungardt spoke regarding the CIP plan update. Mike went over his spreadsheet that was given to the Council. It was the consensus of the Council to get an estimate on putting the water line down 7th street and to see how much of the work the Public Works Department can do themselves. Mike also stated he would have the utility rate analysis at the next meeting.

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to adopt ordinance 835 the 2011 Standard Traffic Ordinance code. Mike McAfee seconded. Motion passed 4-0

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to adopt ordinance 836 the 2011 Uniform Public Offense Code. Mike McAfee seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Ordinance 837 An ordinance allowing for a special event permit for cereal malt beverage or alcoholic liquor to be served for special events was submitted for approval.

Dave Rogers moved to adopt ordinance 837 a special event permit for cereal malt beverage and to charge \$50.00 per day not to exceed \$200.00. Council would have to approve each application. Councilman Mike McAfee seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

City Superintendent Chris Cross gave a public works department activity report.

Chief Gillespie gave the Police Department report. Chief Gillespie discussed the upcoming CJIS audit. Chief Gillespie also discussed the narrow band updates with the County.

Fire Chief Robert Thomas gave a brief fire department activity report.

Dave Rogers moves to go into executive session for 20 minutes to discuss personnel. Mike McAfee seconded. Motion passed 4-0. Chief Gillespie, Fire Chief Thomas, City Supt. Cross and Attorney Patrick Reavey were asked to stay.

The meeting went into executive session at 7:15 p.m.

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to come out of executive session at 7:33 only the item mentioned was discussed

Dave Rogers moved to go into Executive session for 10 minutes to discuss personnel matters. Councilman McAfee seconded. Motion passed 4-0. Chief Gillespie and Attorney Reavey were asked to stay.

The meeting went into executive session at 7:35

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to come out of executive session at 7:45 only the item mentioned was discussed. Councilman Ryan Young seconded.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to go into executive session for 5 minutes to discuss personnel matters. Councilman McAfee seconded. Attorney Reavey was asked to stay.

The meeting went into executive session at 7:50

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to come out of executive session at 7:55 only the item mentioned was discussed. Councilman Young seconded.
