The regular council meeting of the City of Wellsville was held September 14th, 2011 at Wellsville City Hall, 411 Main St, Wellsville, KS 66092. Councilmen present were Mike McAfee, Ryan Young, Jared Eggleston, Corey Cunningham and Dave Rogers. Department Heads present were City Supt. Chris Cross and Fire Chief Robert Thomas.

Councilman Ryan Young spoke regarding the proposed sales tax increase. City Attorney Patrick Reavey spoke about pledging the monies for special purposes. It was the consensus for Patrick to research the old ordinance to possibly use the sales tax ordinance for streets, sidewalks or sewer funds.

Dave Rogers moved to table the fire works display until and ordinance was drawn up at the next Council Meeting. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed to table 5-0.

City Supt. Cross gave the public works activity report.

Fire Chief Thomas gave the Fire Department report.

Councilman Mike McAfee moved to go into executive Session for 10 minutes to discuss personnel. Corey Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 5-0
