The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, September 14th 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the Wellsville City Hall meeting room, located at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Jared Eggleston, Dave Rogers and Cory Cunningham. Department heads present were City Superintendent Christopher Cross, Police Chief John Blair, Building Inspector Wes Brown and City Attorney Patrick Reavey via phone.

Councilman Ryan Eiche and Chuck Rutledge were absent.

The pledge of allegiance and Invocation were given.

The Mayor called the meeting to order.

Councilman Cory Cunningham moved to approve the consent agenda. Councilman Dave Rogers seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

The mayor opened the meeting up to the public. There were no public comments.

Natalie Patton gave a Wellsville Days update and stated the theme this year is "Take me out to the ball game". The kids zone will be adding a rock wall and a pitching and batting cage. Natalie stated she has some local entertainment this year. Public works will be in charge of barricades and trash cans.

Gregg Neis and Laura Vogt gave a presentation from Heartland Payment Systems. Council discussed out sourcing the payroll, they would do W-2's as well.

Councilman Cory Cunningham moved to contract with Heartland Payment Systems. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

City Superintendent Christopher Cross gave the public works activity report. He stated that the street sweeping cost was estimated at \$5300 but we could bring it down to around \$3000 if we eliminated some streets. Chris recommended we build the street sweeping into the cost next year.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to sweep all of the streets at a cost of approximately \$5300.00. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Chris stated that the backhoe needs tires on the front and back. The approximate cost is \$1300.00 from Tire Town.

Councilman Cory Cunningham moved to approve the tires. Councilman Dave Rogers seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Police Chief John Blair gave the Police Department activity report. Chief Blair met with Allen Radcliff the radio system may be put off until June or July of next year. The portables are getting worn out he has 3 that he shares with all of the officers. The county will let them use six more for Wellsville Days.

Building Inspector Wes Brown asked for an executive session regarding personnel.

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved for a 20 minute executive session to discuss personnel Councilman Dave Rogers seconded. Council went into executive session at 6:45 pm with City Attorney Patrick Reavey and City Councilman Chuck Rutledge via phone.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to come out of executive session at 7:00 p.m. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

No motions were made and only the above mentioned item was discussed.

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to go back into executive session for 30 minutes to discuss personnel. Councilman Dave Rogers seconded. Motion passed 4-0. Council went back into executive session at 7:05 p.m with Patrick Reavey via phone and city Clerk Tammy Jones.

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to come out of executive session. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Council came out of executive session at 7:27 p.m. only the above mentioned item was discussed and no motions were made.

Councilman Cory Cunningham moved to go into executive session for 10 minutes. Councilman Dave Rogers seconded. Motion passed 4-0. Council went back into executive session at 7:30 p.m.

Councilman Cory Cunningham moved to come out of executive session. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Council came out of executive session at 7:40 p.m. only the above mentioned item was discussed and no motions were made.

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to accept Wes Brown's retirement affect Oct. 1st Councilman Dave Rogers seconded. Motion passed 4-0

Councilman Cory Cunningham moved to accept Erin Eggleston's resignation affective September 23rd. Councilman Dave Rogers seconded. Motion passed 4-0

Councilman Cory Cunningham moved to adjourn. Councilman Dave Rogers seconded. Motion passed 4-0.
