The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, September 24, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. in the Wellsville City Hall meeting room, located at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Jared Eggleston, Cory Cunningham and Dave Rogers. Department heads present were Chief Blair, City Superintendent Christopher Cross and Building Inspector Wes Brown. Also present were City Attorney Patrick Reavey and City Engineer Mike Brungardt.

Councilmen Mike McAfee and Dave Edwards were absent.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to approve the consent agenda. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 3-0

The Mayor opened the hearing up for public comments.

There were no public comments.

Tom Yahl with the City of Ottawa Planning gave a presentation regarding the healthy community incentive.

Citizen Lee Martin spoke to the council regarding the stop sign at Maple Terrace and Downey. Mr. Martin would rather the City look at different avenues instead of using the stop sign to slow speeders down.

Councilman Cory Cunningham move to approve Ordinance 865 to place a stop sign at Downey Drive. Motion failed.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to leave the stop sign in for 30 days on the trial basis then revisit Ordinance 865. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 2-1

Councilman Cory Cunningham voted no.

Terry Moyer spoke to the council regarding code violations and the complaint forms and how the process works. He suggested that a plan be put in place for how to handle these violations. The consensus of the council was to check with other cities such as Baldwin, Spring Hill, Edgerton etc. to see what there complaint process was and if complaint forms need to be signed.

City Superintendent Christopher Cross gave the Public works report.

Chief John Blair gave the Police Department activity report.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to accept Mike McAfee's resignation. Councilman Jarred Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to go into executive session for 15 minutes to discuss personnel and Attorney client privilege. Councilman Cory seconded.

Council went into executive session at 8:30.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to come out of executive session. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Council came out of executive session at 8:45 no motions were made and only the above topic was mentioned.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 3-0.
