The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, September 28<sup>th</sup> 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the Wellsville City Hall meeting room, located at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Jared Eggleston, Chuck Rutledge, Cory Cunningham, Ryan Eiche and Dave Rogers. Department heads present were Police Chief John Blair and City Superintendent Christopher Cross.

The pledge of allegiance and Invocation were given.

The Mayor called the meeting to order.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge moved to approve the consent agenda. Councilman Ryan Eiche seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

The Mayor opened the meeting up to the public. There were no public comments.

Leslie Brown spoke about the cemetery conditions and produced photos for the council she thinks it is the worst it has ever been. There are weeds grown up and stones are getting hit by the mowers.

Penny Hargett at 310 West 4<sup>th</sup> has a parking issue with the neighbors. The new neighbor does not agree with where she is parking. Penny produced photos and read a statement. The Mayor stated we would take the culvert out and that would end the dispute.

The parking issue on 4<sup>th</sup> street was also discussed to possibly make it no parking because of the school traffic.

A Special Events permit for Chili- Jacks was discussed for his fish fry fundraiser on October 8<sup>th</sup>.

Councilman Cory Cunningham moved to approve the fundraiser for Chili Jacks on October 8<sup>th</sup>. Councilman Chuck Rutledge seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

City Superintendent Christopher Cross gave the public works activity report. He presented the council with a worksheet of current projects, upcoming projects and action items. Supt. Cross received 3 bids for the drainage channel at 4<sup>th</sup> and Walnut.

Supt. Cross stated he is installing at least 25 meters a week. Supt. Cross stated in the last 60 days he has used the rear discharger mower and they are no longer blowing wet grass onto stones. The pot holes on first and ash was mentioned. Supt Cross said he is planning on fixing that intersection in the near future.

Chief Blair gave the police department activity report. Chief Blair stated Wellsville Days went well with no major issues. Chief Blair had to put tires on car 141 this week. Councilman Jared Eggleston moved to go into executive session for 20 minute to executive session to discuss personnel. Councilman Dave Rogers seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Council went into executive session at 7:00 p.m.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to come out of executive session. Councilman Jared Eggleston seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Council came out of executive session at 7:17 p.m. Only the above mentioned item was discussed and no motions were made.

Councilman Ryan Eiche moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Chuck Rutledge seconded. Motion passed 5-0.
