The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, November 14th 2018 at 6:00 p.m. in the Wellsville City Council meeting room located at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Chuck Rutledge, Tony Stanton and Kiel Lasswell. Department heads present were Chief John Blair and City Superintendent Darien Kerr.

Councilmen Cory Cunningham and David Rogers were absent.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge moved to approve the consent agenda. Councilman Tony Stanton seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments. There were no public comments.

Councilman Kiel Lasswell moved to approve the wire transfer of \$19,756.82 to Nichols and Wolfe. Councilman Tony Stanton seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

City Superintendent Darien Kerr gave the public works activity report. Darien stated that he purchased new Christmas lights for Main Street and City Hall. The cost of the lights is \$936.00. The Chamber donated \$200.00 and the breakfast with Santa donated \$300.00. Mayor Lytle will donate the rest of the monies.

Darien asked council to consider a purchase of a used truck with a utility bed in the amount of \$16,995 with 102,000 miles. He would like to put a snow plow on the front end and use this truck on water leaks that would be fully equipped and ready. Council suggested looking at a newer truck with less miles.

Chief John Blair gave the police department activity report. Chief stated he talked to Larabe Alexander from Ottawa PD about the use of their tranquilizer gun. He stated they only use it maybe once a year. The whole package is \$538.00. Chief Blair stated that our Animal Control Ordinance is very similar to that of Ottawa PD's Ordinance. Chief Blair stated that Larabe Alexander said he would come up if necessary and use his tranquilizer gun if needed.

Council thought the tranquilizer gun is not needed at this time.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Tony Stanton seconded. Motion passed 3-0
