The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, July 10th 2019 at 6:00 p.m. in the Wellsville City Hall meeting room located at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Tony Stanton, David Rogers, Chuck Rutledge and Kiel Lasswell. Department heads present were City Superintendent Darien Kerr, Police Chief John Blair, and Building and planning official Pat Burton.

The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

Councilman Cory Cunningham was absent.

Councilman Kiel Lasswell moved to approve the consent agenda. Councilman Tony Stanton seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments. There were no comments.

County Commissioner Don Stottlemire gave the county's activity report.

Elba Unruh was here to ask council to approve the Prairie Lane Block party again. This year it is Saturday, July 27th at 8:00 p.m. The City was asked to provide barricades again.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge moved to approve the block party for Elba Unruh and Prairie Lane. Councilman Kiel Lasswell seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Gregg Neis talked to the council regarding the budget meeting and time frames. Council suggested having the budget planning meeting on Wednesday, July 24th at 6:00 p.m.

Larry Garrett at 934 Main spoke to council about the pot belly pigs that keep getting out. The residence has been issued a citation regarding the pigs running loose. The court date will be August 12th for that issue. Council agreed to see where the court case stands.

Special events permit for Chili Jacks was discussed for approval for the Chamber golf tournament on September 20th. Councilman Kiel Lasswell approved the special events permit. Councilman Tony Stanton seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Resolution 01-0110-2019 approving the call and early redemption of certain industrial revenue bonds was brought before council. Councilman Kiel Lasswell approved Resolution 01-0110-2019. Councilman Chuck Rutledge seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

The CIP Consultant position was discussed with council. Councilman Stanton, City Engineer Mike Brungardt and Building and codes official Pat Burton interviewed 2 engineering firms for qualifications. McClure and CFS were interviewed. The firms were very close. CFS has already engineered some of our current projects. We are

assuming CFS can hit the ground running faster because they are familiar with the projects. Overall the two firms are very comparable. CFS is who staff has chosen for the next step.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge moved to approve CFS as our design consultant. Councilman Tony Stanton seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

The FCDC invoice for \$2500.00 was brought before council for pay.

Councilman Tony Stanton moved to table the FCDC annual invoice. Councilman Chuck seconded. Motion passed 4-0 to table the FCDC Invoice.

City Superintendent Darien Kerr didn't have any activity to report for the public works department.

Police Chief John Blair gave the police department activity report. Chief Blair reported our new officer is doing well and is being shadowed by another officer and may go on his own next month.

Building and codes official Pat Burton didn't have anything to report. Council asked if Pat would look into a golf cart community.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Kiel Lasswell seconded. Motion passed 4-0.
