The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, September 11th 2019 at 6:00 p.m. in the Wellsville City Council meeting room located at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were David Rogers, Tony Stanton and Cory Cunningham. Department heads present were City Superintendent Darien Kerr, Police Chief John Blair and Planning and codes official Pat Burton.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge and Kiel Lasswell were absent.

Mayor Lytle called the meeting to order.

The Pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

Councilman David Rogers moved to approve the consent agenda. Councilman Tony Stanton seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments. There were no public comments.

County Commissioner Don Stottlemire gave the County activity report.

Councilman Kiel Lasswell entered the meeting at 6:03 p.m.

The Appointment of Mary Huddlestun for the library board was brought before council.

Councilman Cory Cunningham moved to approve the appointment of Mary Huddlestun to the Library board. Councilman Tony Stanton seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

City Superintendent Darien Kerr gave the public works activity report. Darien reported that the chip and seal is finished and turned out very well. He will street sweep in a couple of weeks. Darien also stated he will start on Bertø truck stop tomorrow regarding the water lines. Darien wanted to revisit the comp time discussion for the public works department. Darien requested no extra pay when the Public Works departments are on call. The on call person would get the Friday following their on call time off instead.

Councilman David Rogers moved to let the public works department go to comp time instead of the \$125.00 on call time, with no more than 5 days saved per year. Councilman Tony Stanton seconded. Motion passed 3-1.

Councilman Cory Cunningham was opposed.

Chief John Blair gave the police department activity report.

Building and Codes official Pat Burton did not have anything to report.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Tony Stanton seconded. Motion passed 4-0.
