The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, September 25<sup>th</sup> 2019 at 6:00 p.m. in the Wellsville City Council meeting room located at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were David Rogers, Chuck Rutledge, Cory Cunningham and Tony Stanton. Department heads present were Chief John Blair, City Superintendent Darien Kerr, Planning and Codes Director Pat Burton and City Engineer Mike Brungardt.

Councilman Kiel Lasswell was absent.

The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

The Mayor called the meeting to order.

Councilman Tony Stanton moved to approve the consent agenda. Councilman Chuck Rutledge seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments. There were no public comments.

County Commissioner Don Stottlemire gave the County activity report. The revitalization program was discussed. They were all approved to move forward. The planning director Larry Walrod was asked to work on a solar plan, the second public hearing will be in October. The public works is working with FEMA. There will be a summit meeting coming up in November. United Way discussed the need for a Homeless Shelter in Franklin County. They reported that there are approximately 200 people considered homeless in Franklin County.

The CFS Engineers agreement for fee proposal was brought before council by City Engineer Mike Brungardt. The firm that was awarded the contract for overseeing these projects was CFS Engineers. They provided a scope of services and the lump sum fee are \$167,438.00. The proposal does not include construction observation fees. The schedule will be set at the kickoff meeting.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge moved to have the Mayor sign the proposal with CFS Engineers for \$167,438.00. Councilman Dave Rogers seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

City Superintendent Darien Kerr gave the public works activity report. The Mayor asked Darien about the project on 4<sup>th</sup> street regarding the ditches, tubing, and gutters.

Chief Blair gave the police department activity report. The officers received training on Medical response.

Building official Pat Burton gave the Planning department activity report.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Tony Stanton seconded. Motion passed 4-0.
