The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on November 13th 2019 at 6:00 p.m. in the Wellsville City Council meeting room located at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Dave Rogers, Kiel Lasswell, Tony Stanton and Cory Cunningham. Department heads present were Chief John Blair and Building and Codes Official Pat Burton.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge was absent.

The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

The Mayor called the meeting to order.

Councilman Tony Stanton moved to approve the consent agenda. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments. There were no public comments.

Fire Chief Robert Thomas spoke to council regarding burning leaves in ditches. Chief Thomas gave the council a rough draft of the burn permit and rough draft ordinance for council's review. The burns will be allowed on Saturday's only. There would be no open burning from May 1st to September 30th. You would have to come to City Hall to receive a permit.

The City Clerk will send the information on to the City Attorney for review and bring back to council the new ordinance for approval.

Chief Blair gave the police department activity report. Chief Blair said the Hallowesta went very well. The first responders were recognized at the First Methodist Church.

Building and codes official Pat Burton gave the report for the Codes Department. Pat is starting on the temporary and permanent easements. Pat will have a full set of plans so they can see the entire project when talking to residents regarding the easements.

Pat said that 4th street was patched for a temporary fix and will be done correctly at a later date.

Councilman Cory Cunningham moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Tony Stanton seconded. Motion passed 4-0.
