The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, December 9th, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. in the Wellsville City Hall meeting room, located at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Dave Rogers, Chuck Rutledge, Cory Cunningham and Luke Henry. Department heads present were City Superintendent Darien Kerr, Chief of Police John Blair and Building and Codes official Pat Burton.

Councilman absent was Natalie Patton.

The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to approve the consent agenda. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments.

Resident Randall Drake (605 Oak) spoke up about Blue Nile Contractors that did some of the City work in his area. Mr. Drake stated that the work was left undone, with sink holes, trash, dirt work, trash and other items.

Pat Burton said that he contacted Blue Nile via email again. City staff has been in contact with the company for quite some time regarding this issue and the lack of finishing and cleaning of the area.

County Commissioner Don Stottlemire gave the county activity report.

The Christmas bonuses were brought before council.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to approve Christmas bonuses as in the memorandum as amended to allow a full bonus for employee Chase O'Connor. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

City Superintendent Darien Kerr gave the Public works activity report. Darien sold some items on Purple Wave for \$6255.00. Darien would like to purchase mixers or bubblers for the three lift stations in the amount of \$8994.00 from Lloyd Harold Pumps.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge moved to approve the three bubblers in the amount of \$8994.00. Councilman Dave Rogers seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Chief Blair gave the Police Department activity report.

Building and Codes official Pat Burton gave the planning activity report. There was discussion regarding marking some parking spaces in the down town business for the pick-up of business goods/food.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge moved to go into executive session at 6:27pm to discuss performance of non-elected personnel pursuant to KSA 75-4319 (b) (1). The open meeting will resume in City Council chambers at 6:37 p.m.

Councilman Dave Rogers seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Councilman Dave Rogers moved to come out of executive session. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

No motions were made and only the above mentioned item was discussed.
