The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council meeting was held on October 13th, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. in the City Hall meeting room located at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Luke Henry, Natalie Patton, Chuck Rutledge and Dave Rogers. Department heads present were City Superintendent Darien Kerr and Building and Codes official Pat Burton.

Councilman Cory Cunningham was absent.

The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting and the pay vouchers. Councilman Luke Henry seconded. Motion passed 4-0

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments.

Economic Development Director Paul Bean stated he will be in Wellsville from 9-noon each day at Hot of the Press if anyone wants to talk to him

County Commissioner Don Stottlemire gave the county report. Don stated they approved 2 new road graders with a 4 year cycle with Kansas State Bank. An engineering study will be done on old 50 highway.

Ordinance 918 and ordinance regarding parking was discussed and brought back to council for discussion. There was an error in the Ordinance and it will have to be revised. Also, there were several complaints regarding the no parking on one side of the roadways in Glenwood acres. The idea was to ask residents to try and park in their driveways as much as possible and/or one side of the streets this is from a safety standpoint for EMS/FIRE it is important not to have the streets congested.

Councilman Luke Henry made a motion to resend ordinance 918. Councilman Chuck Rutledge seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

City Superintendent Darien Kerr gave the public works activity report. Darien stated he received a bid from NewCo for the cement work in front of City Hall in the amount of \$102,000. They wouldn't start for 4-6 weeks and the project would take approximately 2 weeks to complete.

Councilman Luke Henry moved to approve the bid from NewCo in the amount of \$102,000. Councilwoman Natalie Patton seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Building and Codes official Pat Burton gave the activity report. Pat had drawings for the council regarding the Police Department offices.

Councilwoman Natalie Patton moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Luke Henry seconded. Motion passed 4-0.
