The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, March 9th, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. in the Wellsville City Hall meeting room, located at 411 Main Street. Councilmen present were Chuck Rutledge, Cory Cunningham, Luke Henry, Nichole Pruitt and Scott Hutchinson. Also present were Building Inspector Pat Burton, Chief of Police Danny Hackler and City Superintendent Darien Kerr.

The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments. There were no public comments.

Councilman Scott Hutchinson moved to approve the consent agenda and the minutes from the February 23rd and the March 2nd meeting. Councilman Luke Henry seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

County Commissioner Don Stottlemire gave the County report.

Bob Hamilton with Kansas Department of Transportation gave the Police Department the Silver award from AAA. Bob stated our department is apart of many programs including SAFE, You DRINK you DRIVE you LOSE.

Ordinance 922 the IRB's with Keim were presented by Phil Wolfe- Bond Council.

Councilman Cory Cunningham moved to approve Ordinance 922 the Issuance by the City not to exceed \$13,000,000 aggregate principal amount of taxable industrial revenue bonds, series 2022 (Keim Boys, LLC Project), to provide funds to acquire, construct and equip a project for Keim Boys, LLC, and approving certain documents and actions in connection with the issuance of said bonds. Councilman Chuck Rutledge seconded.

Motion passed 5-0.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge moved to table the proposed agreement with FRWD 1 until March 30th. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

City Superintendent Darien Kerr gave the Public Works activity report. Darien gave council a quote on 3,430 sq. ft. of sidewalk to remove and replace in the amount of \$68,600.00 from NewCo. Concrete.

Councilman Luke Henry moved to approve NewCo concrete to remove and replace 3,430 sq ft of sidewalk in the amount not to exceed \$68,600.00. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Building Inspector Pat Burton gave the activity report for Building and Planning. He stated he had a meeting with the WJRC about a walking trail and the grants to help out with the costs.

Councilman Scott Hutchinson moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Luke Henry seconded. Motion passed 5-0.
