The regular meeting of the Wellsville City council was held on Wednesday, August 10<sup>th</sup> 2022 at 6:00 p.m. in the Wellsville City meeting room, located at 411 Main Street. Chief Danny Hackler gave the Police Department activity report. He stated framing on the new Police Department should be completed by Friday. Chief Hackler also stated the applicant for the grant position has passed all of his testing.

Chief Hackler asked council permission to send Officer Pelts to (Active Shooter training) in the amount of \$750.00.

Councilman Luke Henry moved to approve the two year contract for the new officer position. He would need to complete the academy training. Councilwoman Nicole Pruitt seconded.

Councilwoman Nicole Pruitt moved to approve the Active Shooter training for Officer Pelts in the amount of \$750.00. Councilman Scott Hutchinson seconded. Motion passed 5-0.
