Department heads present were City Superintendent Darien Kerr and Building and Codes Official Pat Burton.

The Pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

Councilman Scott Hutchinson moved to approve the consent agenda and minutes from the previous meeting. Councilman Luke Henry seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments.

Commissioner Don Stottlemire gave the County report. The board approved the County wide clean up day for 2023. The City of Wellsville's day will be April 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup>. The County approved a new backhoe in the amount of \$132,000 with a trade in.

The Remarkable tablets for council use were discussed. The cost per device is \$600.00 with the pen and case.

Councilman Scott Hutchinson moved to approve the purchase of 6 Re-Mark able tablets in the amount of \$600.00 each for councilman and Mayor. Councilman Luke Henry seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

City Superintendent Darien Kerr gave the Public works activity report. Darien said he needs an auger for the sewer department in the amount of \$7,384.00.

Councilman Luke Henry moved to approve to spend \$7384.00 on a new auger. Councilman Cory Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Building and Codes Official Pat Burton gave council the bids for the new Police Department road. Phelps Engineering did the bid opening.

Councilman Scott Hutchinson moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Luke Henry seconded. Motion passed 5-0.
