Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments. There were no public comments.

The water purchase contract between Water 1 and the City of Wellsville was provided to council for review and approval.

Councilwoman Nichole Pruitt motioned for the Mayor to sign the water contract. Scott seconded.

The Wellsville Days 2023 Sponsorship was discussed. Councilwoman Nichole Pruitt moved to approve \$5000.00 to donate this year to the Wellsville Days Committee. Councilman Luke Henry seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

City Superintendent Darien Kerr gave the public works report. Darien would like to purchase a used grass seeder in the amount of \$2500.00. Councilman Chuck Rutledge motioned to approve \$2500.00 for the new grass seeder. Councilman Scott Hutchinson seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Darien said they started cutting in the new roads at the cemetery.

Sergeant Garcia gave the Police Department activity report. He said they have moved into the new Police Department and the Public works are in the old Police Department building.

Councilman Scott Hutchinson moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Luke Henry seconded. Motion passed 4-0.
