The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, June 11th 2025 at 6:00 p.m. in the meeting room located at 411 Main. Councilmen present were Scott Hutchinson, Chuck Rutledge, Cory Cunningham and Luke Henry. Department heads present were City Superintendent Darien Kerr, Chief Hackler and Building and Codes official Pat Burton.

Councilwoman Nichole Pruitt was absent.

Councilman Hutchinson moved to approve the consent agenda. Councilman Henry seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments. Lorrie Glass Coffman from the Chamber of Commerce said the visitors guide is being printed. The events coming up: Justin White, Friday 27th at Chili Jacks from 7-9 p.m. There will be a ribbon cutting for Restorative Health at 511 Main the 27th at noon and an open house following.

County Commissioner Don Stottlemire gave the County report.

Advent Health- Madeline Jones spoke about the July 11th ribbon cutting from 11-1 P.M. Before the ceremony they would like to block off the front of the clinic with some food vendors such as Hot off the Press, Las Catrinas and On the Bricks.

The 4th and 6th Street overlay discussion was brought up. Council discussed just fixing the entrances right now and the streets later when we can put it in the budget. The entrances were \$16,000 to fix from Hosfelt paving.

Councilman Cunningham moved to approve the quote from Hosfelt Paving for the entrances on 4th and 6th not to exceed \$17,000 Councilman Hutchinson seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Councilman Cunningham left the meeting.

City Superintendent Darien Kerr gave the Public Works activity report.

Chief Hackler gave the Police Department report. Emergency Management provided a sheet for reimbursement from the storm. The new F-150 is in service today and both the 2014 SUV's will be sold.

Building and Codes Official Pat Burton said he has been meetings about Community Development. Pat Said he met with the builder on Pendleton and 8th street. He has asked them to fix the issues and have an Engineer study.

A study session was discussed for no parking on certain streets the study session will be held on July 9th following the council meeting.

Councilman Hutchinson moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Henry seconded. Motion passed 3-0.
