The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, July 9th 2025 at 6:00 p.m. in the meeting room located at 411 Main. Councilmen present were Cory Cunningham, Luke Henry, Chuck Rutledge, Scott Hutchinson and Nichole Pruitt. Department heads present were City Superintendent Darien Kerr, Chief Hackler and Building and Codes official Pat Burton.

Mayor Lytle was absent.

President Luke Henry called the meeting to order with the pledge of allegiance.

Councilman Hutchinson moved to approve the consent agenda and the minutes from the previous meeting. Councilman Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

President Henry opened the meeting up for public comments.

Lorrie Glass Coffman with the Chamber of Commerce invited council to the Advent Health ribbon cutting on Friday the 11th. The Chamber is starting their membership drive. Lorrie also passed out the new visitors guide directory to council.

Paul Bean with the FCDC spoke to council about the grant we didn't get for the Safe Pathways. The feedback was that they wanted more economic impact. Paul did put in for safe roads around the County it be up to 6months before we hear anything.

Chief Hackler discussed the no parking signs around town that the council would like to see. Chief stated Pendleton, 8th street, 7th street, 6th street, 4th street from 33 to Ash, Hunt, Main from 4th and 1st from 33 to the City limits. In Glenwood everything hydrant side would be no parking. Council discussed adding Stafford E of 33 for no parking as well as a speed limit sign on Stafford.

Council consensus was to send it to the Attorney to put together the Ordinances.

Chief Hackler gave the Police Department activity report. Chief received the training on the message board. He plans on deploying it on 7th street for speeding within the next week or two.

Building and Codes official Pat Burton gave the department review. Pat said he is caught up on the mowing letters. Pat is meeting with the Attorney on Tuesday regarding some houses for condemnations.

Councilman Hutchinson moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 5-0.
