The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, February 11<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m. in the meeting room located at 411 Main. Councilmen present were Chuck Rutledge, Luke Henry, Scott Hutchinson, and Cory Cunningham. Department heads present were City Superintendent Darien Kerr, Sergeant Garcia and Building and codes official Pat Burton and Guy Price.

Councilwoman Pruitt was absent.

The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

Councilman Hutchinson moved to approve the consent agenda and the minutes from the previous meeting. Councilman Henry seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments. There were no public comments.

Paul Bean with the FCDC gave the grant updates.

Council discussed the FCDC dues. The city was asked to give \$8000.00 to the FCDC for dues for 2026.

Councilman Rutledge moved to approve \$8000.00 dues. Councilman Hutchinson seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

The city wide clean up was brought before council for discussion. City Clerk will check with Ottawa Sanitation to find out costs for April.

Councilman Hutchinson moved to table that discussion. Councilman Henry seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

City Superintendent Kerr asked to purchase the new truck that he put in the budget. Darien also talked about the meter station and controls which came in at \$11,400 which was not a budgeted item.

Councilman Henry motioned to moved forward to the purchase of the truck and snow plow and defer payments until 2027. Councilman Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Councilman Henry moved to purchase the snow plow in the amount of \$11,000 Councilman Cunningham seconded.

Councilman Hutchinson moved to approve the purchase of the controls in the amount of \$11,400.00. Councilman Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Sergeant Garcia gave the Police Department update.

Building and codes official Pat Burton and Guy Price gave the building and codes gave the department update.

Councilman Rutledge moved to go into executive session at 6:35 p.m. to discuss performance of non-elected personnel pursuant to KSA 75-4319(b) (1). The open meeting will resume in the City Council chambers at 6:50 p.m. Councilman Hutchinson seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Councilman Hutchinson moved to come out of executive session at 6:50 p.m. Councilman Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

No motions were made and only the above mentioned item was discussed.

Councilman Hutchinson moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 4-0.
