The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, March 11th at 6:00 p.m. in the meeting room located at 411 Main. Councilmen present were Nichole Pruitt, Chuck Rutledge, Cory Cunningham, Luke Henry and Scott Hutchinson. Department heads present were City Superintendent Darien Kerr, Chief Hackler and Building and codes official Guy Price.

The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

Councilman Rutledge moved to approve the consent agenda and the minutes of the previous meeting. Councilman Henry seconded. Motion passed 5-0

Mayor Lytle opened the meeting up for public comments.

Lorrie Glass Coffman with the Chamber said there will be a chamber coffee March 20th at 9 at the United Methodist Church. The Chamber sign will have to come down within the next month. Lorrie asked council for suggestions on where to re-locate the sign.

Paul Bean with the FCDC gave the council an update.

Deb McCullough spoke about the Aaron Patton corn hole tournament. The tournament will be held on April 18th. There will be a raffle and corn hole tournament at Chili Jacks. The time is 11 am for registration and the tourney starts at noon and ends at 5 p.m.

The City Wide clean up was brought before council and discussion regarding the voucher system that the transfer station suggested.

Councilwoman Pruitt moved to use the voucher system. Councilman Henry seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

City Superintendent gave the public works activity report.

Chief Hackler gave the Police Department activity report. The playground equipment for the playground was discussed and quotes were given to council. Option 1 has a playground equipment for the smaller children, 7 benches and engineered wood fiber surfacing and a border for \$35,282.01. Option 2 has the playground equipment 7 benches poured in place safety surfacing and concrete curbing for \$60,802.13.

Councilman Rutledge moved to go with option 1 with 3 benches, a sidewalk and no border not to exceed \$35,000. Councilman Hutchinson seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Councilman Rutledge moved to go into executive session at 6:40 p.m. to discuss performance of non-elected personnel pursuant to KSA 75-4319(b)(1) The open meeting

will resume in the City Council chambers at 6:55 p.m. Councilman Hutchinson seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Councilman Hutchinson moved to come out of executive session. Councilwoman Pruitt seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

No motions were made and only the above mentioned item was discussed.

Councilman Hutchinson moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Henry seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Meeting adjourned at 6:56 p.m.
