The regular meeting of the Wellsville City Council was held on Wednesday, March 25th 2026 at 6:00 p.m. in the meeting room located at 411 Main room located at 411 Main. Councilmen present were Cory Cunningham, Scott Hutchinson and Luke Henry. Department heads present were Chief Hackler, and Building and codes officials Pat Burton and Guy Price.

Councilman Chuck Rutledge and Nichole Pruitt were absent.

The pledge of allegiance and invocation were given.

Councilman Hutchinson moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting and the consent agenda. Councilman Henry seconded. Motion passed 3-0

The Wellsville Days sponsorship was brought before council.

Councilman Henry motioned to donate \$10,000 to the Wellsville day's committee. Councilman Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

The Caseys sign re-location was discussed and plans provided to council. Casey's submitted an application for a new location and new sign for the C-Store located at 1002 Poplar. With the highway reconstruction getting underway, Casey's exiting signage must be moved and replaced out of KDOT right of way. This means the new sign needs to be placed west of the existing sign. They have proposed a pole sign in the location shown on the drawing. The sign does not meet the set-back requirements, but special circumstances require the sign to be re-located.

Councilman Hutchinson motion to approve the new Casey's sign re-location regarding the K-33 expansion. Councilman Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Councilwoman Pruitt entered the meeting.

Chief Hackler gave the Police Department report. Chief said he is going over new applicants.

The Building and Codes official Pat Burton asked for a re-imbusement resolution but we do not have that yet. Next meeting we will have a temporary note funds to be repaid.

Councilman Henry moved to acknowledge and approve the action of pulling money out of the permits to pay for SBD bills. Councilman Hutchinson seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Councilman Hutchinson moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Henry seconded.
