The regular meeting of the Wellsville City was held on Wednesday, May 13<sup>th</sup> 2026 at 6:00 p.m. in the meeting room located at 411 Main. Councilmen present were Chuck Rutledge, Cory Cunningham, Scott Hutchinson, Nichole Pruitt and Luke Henry. Department heads present were Building and Codes Officials Pat Burton and Guy Price, Sgt. Garcia was present for the Police Department.

Mayor Lytle was absent.

Councilman Hutchinson moved to approve the consent agenda and the minutes of the previous meeting. Councilman Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Councilman Luke Henry opened the meeting up for public comments. Lorrie Glass Coffman with the Chamber of Commerce invited council to Attebury homes for a coffee from 9-11a.m. at 412 Ash Street. Next Thursday the A&W will have a ribbon cutting with free root beer floats provided by Kansas State Bank.

Lorrie's stated this is her last meeting as chamber coordinator. President Jackson Dwyer will introduce Sydney Kuhn who will be taking over that position.

County Commissioner Don Stottlemire gave the County report.

Paul Bean with Ottawa FCDC spoke that the bridge on John Brown should be accomplished by the end of the year. Paul talked about the Safe Pathways to school, they questioned some items on the grant which we didn't get this time, but will try again in the fall.

Ordinance 946 assigning a natural gas franchise to the City of Wellsville was introduced. Councilwoman Pruitt moved to approve Ordinance 946. Councilman Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Councilman Hutchinson moved to approve the Resolution 01-0513-2026 extending hours of alcohol sales within the state statute. Councilman Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Sergeant Garcia gave the Police Department report.

Guy Price gave the Building and codes activity report. Guy said that A & W did open on schedule Monday morning. He said that they will be moving along with the demolition of the trailer park.

Councilman Cunningham asked what they are going to do with the trees that they are taking out at Casey's and TA. Pat said they are bull dozing them down. Councilman

Cunningham suggested asking if the WJRC could use them. Pat said he would look into it.

Councilman Hutchinson moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Cunningham seconded. Motion passed 5-0.
